

JUNIOR K.G. ADMISSION FAQs

PROCEDURE FOR ADMISSION TO JUNIOR K. G. 2020 - 21

Please read the Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ) before filling the admission form.

General Questions:

1. What is the age criterion for admission to Junior K.G. for the academic year 2020 - 2021?

The child should have completed 4 years of age as on 30th September 2020.

2. What if my child is few days underage?

The child should have completed 4 years of age as on 30th September 2020. If your child is underage, admission will not be granted.

3. What are the criteria's for admission to Junior K.G. for the academic year 2020 - 2021?

Preference for admissions will be given to:-

- a. All Catholics will be granted admissions.
- b. Priority will be given to Christians.
- c. Children of benefactors and well – wishers will be given preference.
- d. Past pupils and siblings can also be considered.
- e. Admission will also be given to people residing within 2km. & who, can come personally to drop the child to school and take the child home.
- f. Only two siblings of a family will be given admission.

4. What if we don't stay in the preferred area?

Admission will be granted depending on availability of the seats.

5. Will there be a formal interview of the child?

No. There is no formal interview of the child. However, there is an interactive session scheduled for each applicant. Details of the interactive session will be given later.

6. Is my child's admission guaranteed once I submit my application form?

No. There is no guarantee of admissions. For details kindly check the criteria of admission.

7. How should I collect the form?

The form will be available online. Check www.donbosconashik.org / Admissions → Pre – Primary → Junior K.G.

8. Is it possible to purchase an application form and fill it up offline?

The application form has to be filled up online only. No paper based forms will be issued.

9. Can I save the form and complete it up later?

You need to fill the application form in one sitting only. There is no facility to save a partially filled form and complete it later.

10. What if my computer crashes while filling the application form?

In case your computer crashes while filling the application form, please visit the site again and re - fill the form.

11. How do I know that my application has been successfully submitted?

A unique registration number will be generated on your screen, once you submit your application form. Generation of this number indicates that your form has been successfully submitted.

12. What happens once I submit my form online?

- You will receive a unique registration number on the screen and through email, which should be noted down. (Kindly fill in the correct email ID's of both parents).
- You will have to pay the Application form fee of Rs. 500/- at the school office on 4th & 5th March 2020 between 9:00am to 12:00noon.
- Kindly note you should use the unique registration number to check any updates to the application by the school administration.

13. Do I need to upload the photograph of my child?

Yes. You need to upload the photograph on your form, through online admission.

14. Are there any specifications for the photograph?

The photograph should meet the following requirements:

- The photograph should be a recent one.
- The photograph should show the full face of the child clearly.

15. What documents should I bring for the interaction session?

- Print out of the form along with the following documents:-
 1. Xerox copy of the birth certificate. (Original to be brought for verification.)
 2. Xerox copy of the child's Aadhar card, if available. (Original to be brought for verification.)

Kindly note:

- i. The birth certificate should have the following below mentioned information completely in English only. If the birth certificate is in any other language then a translation in English will have to be provided while **confirming** the admission.
- ii. **The original birth certificate will have to be submitted to the school only when the admission is confirmed, which will remain with the school forever and will not be returned. Please make arrangements to have a duplicate copy for yourself.**
- iii. **Laminated originals will not be accepted. If you have laminated the originals, then an affidavit mentioning all these information in below mentioned order will have to be submitted while confirming the admission.**
- iv. The required information is mentioned below:-
 - a. Name of the child

- b. Name of the father
- c. Name of the mother
- d. Date of Birth (in words or figures)
- e. Place of Birth
- f. Religion (Optional – To be mentioned, if the religion has to be entered in child's school record).
- g. Child's Mother tongue.

3. One recent passport size photograph of the child to be uploaded on the form.
4. For Catholics, additionally please attach the Xerox copy of the Baptism certificate (Original to be brought for verification) and the letter from the Parish Priest (original).
5. For Christians, kindly bring the Original Baptism certificate & it's Xerox of both the Parents & child and a letter from the Parish Priest. (original)
6. Xerox copy of the residence proof in the name of the parents. (Electricity bill / BSNL bill / Ration card / any other Government document) (Original to be brought for verification)

- The date and time for the interaction session will be displayed on the Notice board. Both Parents will have to come to the school with your ward for the interaction session.
- Your application will not be considered for the admission procedure if you do not come for the interaction session.

16. Is it possible to change the date and time for the interaction session?

The date and time allotted for the interaction session cannot be changed.

17. What happens after the interaction session?

After the interaction session, the results will be displayed up on the Notice Board.
